ULBs are also key vehicles for implementing social welfare programmes that cater to the needs of vulnerable and marginalised communities. As the foundational grassroots institutions of urban governance, ULBs are instrumental in driving reforms, strengthening service delivery, and shaping sustainable and inclusive cities. Realising the contribution of ULBs in defining India's urban future, the following sub – themes are identified under the broad theme:

1. Capacity building for financial strengthening of ULBs
2. Monetisation and management of municipal assets
3. Water supply, sewerage, drainage and solid waste management
4. Innovative financing mechanisms like PPP, InvITs etc. for funding infrastructure projects including loan structuring
5. Digital enablement

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES

1. The article should be submitted at aptiwari@hudco.org, atulsh@hudco.org and tuhinarana@hudco.org.in in MS-Word format, font-Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing and should be between 3,000- 5,000 words in length.
2. The first page of the article should include: i) the paper's title ii) a 200-word abstract that emphasises the paper's contribution to the field of architectural/ planning /social aspects, etc. iii) the name(s), position(s), professional or academic affiliation(s), and email ID(s) of the author(s), as well as the full postal address of the corresponding author.
3. Please ensure that references are complete, have been arranged alphabetically by author surname and checked for accuracy.
4. Figures/tables /graphs used in the article should also be sent in high resolution files separately in JPG/ JPEG format along with article file. Proper caption and source should be mentioned.
5. Declaration that the paper/article is an original work neither of the author, and neither published nor under consideration for publication elsewhere should accompany the article/ paper.
