



**Study Visit of 25 member International Participants Team
under ITEC Training programme of HSMI to Chandigarh
organized by Regional Office-Chandigarh**

HUDCO Regional Office- Chandigarh organised study visit of 25 participants from 22 countries at Chandigarh from March 20th – 22nd, 2025 as part of HUDCO's HSMI training program on "Right to Adequate Housing in the context of Habitat III New Urban Agenda" under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation Programme (ITEC). ITEC is a bilateral assistance program run by the Government of India, focusing on addressing the needs of developing countries through innovative technological cooperation. During their visit, the participants were given field visit exposure to the following running projects :-

1. Affordable Rental Housing Complex (ARHC) constituting 2195 flats with carpet area of 24.54 sq mt. for urban migrants/ poor under PMAY at Maloya, Chandigarh implemented by Chandigarh Housing Board
2. Municipal Corporation Chandigarh's Water Filtration Unit for treatment of raw water for supply to the entire city.
3. Horticulture Waste Processing Plant at 3BRD run by the Municipal Corporation Chandigarh to process the horticultural waste from the city into compressed brickettes used as green fuel.
4. Construction and Demolition Waste Processing Plant at Industrial Area Phase 1 run by the Municipal Corporation Chandigarh to process the said waste into pavers, PCC block and bricks.
5. Integrated Command and Control Centre ie ICCC under the Chandigarh Smart City project.

The international participants also attended special session at the HUDCO Regional Office, featuring key presentation by Sh Jit Kumar Gupta, ex Advisor, PUDA on the planning aspects of Chandigarh City. An overview of HUDCO Chandigarh operations was also presented. Additionally, visit to key places of cultural interest at Chandigarh was also organised covering cruise at Sukhna Lake, Capitol Complex, Le Corbusier Centre and Nek Chand's Rock Garden.
