# **HUDCO's Contribution in Housing and Urban Development**

Since its inception in 1970, HUDCO continued its mission of improving access to housing for all and providing sustainable infrastructure in human settlements, to improve living conditions of people at large. HUDCO has evolved as the largest institution in India addressing the housing and infrastructure needs of the poor. Loans are offered at very competitive terms with a longer repayment of up to 20 years.

#### Housing

Till January 2024, HUDCO has sanctioned 14,962 housing projects with a total loan component of ₹88,073 crore, out of this ₹83,487 crore has been released

- Over 19.66 million housing units supported through projects.
- 93.48% of housing units supported pertain to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Low Income Group (LIG).
- Separately, through its individual lending window HUDCO Niwas, housing loans to over 3.87 lakh beneficiaries with a loan assistance of ₹6875 crore.

The team together, not only generated fee-based income providing unique design concepts responsive to its clients' diverse requirements, but also contributed towards branding HUDCO as a nationally recognized premier techno financial institution. During the year, work on the prestigious assignments having long gestation periods continued; these included providing

HUDCO is an empaneled Institution for Independent Appraisal of Integrated Management Plans (IMPs) under the National Plan for Conservation of Aquatic Ecosystems (NPCA), a centrally sponsored scheme being implemented by the Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC). During the FY 2023-24, as part of Environmental Engineering Consultancy, HUDCO has carried out appraisal of Integrated Management Plans for five wetlands across India, namely; Tamzey Wetland (Sikkim), Khecheperi Wetland (Sikkim), Yanchentso Wetland (Sikkim), Doyang Wetland (Nagaland) and Thol Wetland (Gujarat) with a total estimated project cost of about Rs. 45 crores. Further, three more IMPs for the wetlandsnamely; Sultanpur National Park IMP (Haryana,) Bhindawas Wildlife Sanctuary IMP Haryana) and Renuka Wetland (Himachal Pradesh), are at different stages of appraisal by HUDCO.

HUDCO registered an impressive performance in all facets of its operations during 2023-24 (upto Jan2024)

- · During the financial year 2022-23, HUDCO mobilized resources aggregating to ₹ 16.161.00 crore from domestic markets, which included, ₹ 10,421.50 crore by way of rupee term loans from banks, ₹ 3,970.00 crore mobilized through issue of unsecured, Taxable, Non-Convertible Debentures (NCDs) on private placement basis and ₹1,769.50 crore by way of short-term loan from banks, at market competitive rates. As a result, the Company was able to deliver debt financing for various Housing & Infrastructure projects, spread across the Country, at competitive rates. The Company was able to achieve this feat through constant monitoring of the markets, proper timing of its borrowings and appropriate selection of instruments.
- As on 31st December, 2023, HUDCO's overall borrowings stood at ₹ 65,678.78 crore, which comprised of long-term borrowings of ₹62.896.53 crore and short-term borrowing of ₹2,782.25 crore. Further as on 31st December, 2023, the long term borrowing to net worth stood at 3.87 times as against 3.96 times as on 31st March, 2023.
- · The Domestic Debt Instrument(s)/ Banking Sector Loan(s)/ facilities of HUDCO continue to enjoy "AAA; Outlook-Stable" rating- the highest rating on a standalone basis from three domestic Credit Rating agencies, namely, M/s India Rating and Research Pvt. Ltd. (IRRPL), M/s CARE Ratings and M/s ICRA Ltd. Further, the short-term debt instruments of HUDCO enjoys 'A1+; Outlook-Stable' rating, which is highest on a standalone basis.
- · Further, HUDCO for its International Borrowing Programme continued to enjoy International Credit Rating of 'Baa3' with Stable outlook and 'BBB-' with Stable outlook, respectively, from Moody's and FITCH, International Credit Rating Agencies. Each of the above credit ratings is equivalent to India's sovereign rating, and is of investment grade.

# **Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)**

HUDCO has earmarked ₹ 4557 lakh for undertaking CSR activities during the financial year 2023-24 and also allocated the 60 % of the budget for undertaking CSR activities related to 'Health and Nutrition'.

During the current financial year (as on 22.02.2024) ₹ 1317.14 lakh has been released for various ongoing proposals. Further, from the expenditure of ₹ 421.97 lakh (as on 31.01.2024 has been already incurred, expenditure of ₹ 155.33 lakh has been incurred for the projects related to the Health & Nutrition.

Besides the above, CSR assistance for the earlier • Publications ongoing proposals viz. for providing furniture (chairs & Tables/Desk & Bench) for students in 22 Govt Schools of Udham Singh Nagar (Aspirational District), Procurement of Hospital equipment, Kiphire, Nagaland (Aspirational District), Construction of Skill Lab at District Hospital, Wayanad (Aspirational District) and Procurement and installation of Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and Sanitary Napkin disposal machine to 150 Nos. # **Capacity Building and Training**

As part of Capacity Building activity, HUDCO's HSMI conducted 7 webinars and 2 training programmes till February 2024 and imparted training to 714 HUDCO

employees. The webinars for HUDCO employees covered a diverse range of subjects like RTI Act, 2005, Pensions & Other Retirement Benefits, Solutions to Plastic Pollution, Ethics and Governance, Cyber hygiene and Security, Awareness Building about PIDPI and Public Procurement. The themes for training programmes for HUDCO employees included Recent Developments in Loan Recovery Mechanisms - Legal Aspects (SARFAESI, DRT including OTS and IBS 2016 and Retail Finance for HUDCO Officials - including bulk loan.

In addition to the above, HUDCO's HSMI also conducted 2 physical training programmes and an online training programme for 62 overseas participants under the Indian Technical And Economic Cooperation(ITEC) implementation of major projects viz. Procurement of programme of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), Govt. Medical Equipment's at IPGMER, Kolkata, Construction of India. The themes covered under the ITEC programmes included Realizing The Right To Adequate Housing in the Context of Habitat III New Urban Agenda - Policies, Planning & Practices, Housing the Urban Poor – Policy, Planning and Implementation – Indian Dehradun and Development of Children Park in Experience and Decarbonising Habitat Programme -Meeting The Global Targets.



During FY:2022-23, eight entries were conferred the HUDCO Best Practices Award.

# **HUDCO's Role in implementation of Flagship Programs of Government of India**

## Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U)

HUDCO is providing support to MoHUA for the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) –(Urban) Housing for All (HFA). This includes scrutiny of projects submitted by State Governments under the three verticals of PMAY namely; AHP, ISSR and BLC. Besides, HUDCO is the Central Nodal Agency for its fourth vertical - Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS). Further, for meeting fund requirement of State/ULB share HUDCO also offers viability gap funding/ loan assistance to meet the requirement beyond the grant available from Government of India. HUDCO so far has funded 14 schemes in the 5 States – Chhattisgarh, Uttarakhand, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Kerala with total loan assistance of ₹14,458 crore, out of which an amount of ₹ 12.536 crore has been disbursed covering 9,18,725 Dwelling Units.

As part of Desk-cum-site scrutiny of DPRs for Centrally Sponsored verticals of PMAY-HFA HUDCO assists the MoHUA in scrutiny and inspection of sample projects / DPRs under the 3 verticals of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) – (Urban) - Housing for All (HFA), i.e., Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), In-situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) & Beneficiaries Led Construction (BLC) projects, before the projects are put up for consideration of sanction of central assistance by the Ministry. Up to 31st January 2024, HUDCO has

cumulatively carried out site and desk scrutiny for 620 projects with project cost of ₹59,767.24 crore having Central share of ₹ 18,900.29 crore for total 12.79 lakh DUs in 444 town/cities under 34 States/UTs of India. These projects include 62 AHP projects, 536 BLC projects and 22 ISSR projects.

As on 31st January, 2024, HUDCO, as CNA, has released cumulative gross CLSS subsidy of ₹ 2665.89 Crore to 1,13,091 beneficiaries of EWS/ LIG/MIG categories throughout the country. Out of this, an amount of ₹ 2322.59 crore has been disbursed to 96,751 EWS/LIG category beneficiaries while ₹ 343.30 Crore has been disbursed to 16.340 MIG category beneficiaries.

HUDCO has extended loan of ₹ 20000 crore to the Building Material and Technology Promotion Council

(BMTPC), as Extra Budgetary Resources by issue of 'Gol fully serviced Bonds'.




### **Recent HUDCO Initiatives**


